Dr Bierens, a clinically active anaesthesiologist, is also thesis co-ordinator for the European Masters in Disaster Medicine; Visiting Professor at the research group for Emergency and Disaster Medicine at the Vrije Universiteit Brussel (Belgium); and Visiting Professor at the Doctoral School in Global Health, Humanitarian Aid and Disaster Medicine at the University of Piemonte in Italy. He is considered an authority in the field of drowning and other aquatic emergencies and co-ordinated the first World Congress on Drowning.
