GEOFFREY FLAVELL LECTURE

This fast-paced lecture provides an overview of the invention and diffusion of several diagnostic and therapeutic technologies and procedures that transformed the care of patients with heart disease during the twentieth century. These include electrocardiography, closed heart surgery, cardiac catheterization, open-heart surgery among others. The talk will reveal how developments in cardiology encouraged innovations in cardiac surgery and vice-versa. It will also illustrate how political, economic, and social factors influenced the evolution of these twin disciplines.

These developments are described in his recent book *Caring for the Heart: Mayo Clinic and the Rise of Specialization* (Oxford University Press, 2015), which Valentin Fuster describes as “a unique and brilliant platform to understand the complex interplay of medical, scientific, technological, social and economic forces that over a century have shaped the practice of medicine and cardiology.”
