‘The William Morris Gallery is the only public gallery devoted to the life and legacy of William Morris: designer, writer and political activist. Housed in the Georgian villa that was his childhood home (one of London’s best examples of Georgian domestic architecture), it presents the world’s biggest collection of his works

through award-winning displays.’

After a Welcome tea / coffee, start with a **‘Meet the Man’ tour by a Museum Curator**. Have a **light lunch in the private Acanthus Room**, and plenty of **time to browse the collection**, and the **special exhibition ‘Cultural Revolution: Chinese Revolutionary posters’**, for which we shall have a further, short introductory talk. This is a touring exhibition organised by the Ashmolean Museum, University of Oxford.
