Dr Tina Matthews has been a Consultant Cellular Pathologist for 25 years. She also has a passion for teaching, history of medicine and cycling long distances. In 1996 she passed the examination for the DHMSA and has been involved with the Faculty ever since. She became a Yeoman of the Society of Apothecaries in 2007 and a Liveryman in 2011. Following a period on the Faculty Executive Committee she became the first female President in 2014. During this period of office the lure of the Faculty's offerings became irresistible and she joined the Philosophy and Ethics of Healthcare Course, achieving the Diploma in July 2018. This talk is based upon the Dissertation submitted as part of that examination.
