Chief Scientific Adviser at the Department for Health and Social Care; previously he was interim Government Chief Scientific Adviser, and Chief Scientific Adviser at the Department for International Development. He has been closely involved in responses to emergencies with international concern including Ebola, Zika, Influenza, the recent Nepal earthquake, and major floods and droughts. The CSA role includes being head of the National Institute for Health Research, and first Deputy Chief Medical Officer for England. He is also Professor of Public and International Health at the London School of Hygiene & Tropical Medicine, Consultant Physician in acute medicine and infectious diseases at UCLH and the Hospital for Tropical Diseases and Gresham Professor Physic at Gresham College.
