EXAMINATION TIMETABLE: 2019

Deadline for receipt in the Examinations Office of titles and abstracts for the dissertation-essay and test lecture.	Thursday 21 March 2019
Closing date for receipt in the Examinations Office of completed hard copy application form and payment (all candidates). (Applications are not accepted via email or fax.)	4pm on Tuesday 16 April 2019
Due date for submission of completed dissertation-essay	4pm on Friday 24 May 2019
Written papers	Tuesday 11 June 2019
Due date for submission of test lecture précis	4pm on Friday 28 June 2019
Test lecture	Friday 5 July 2019

EXAMINATION FEE

- The examination entry fee for **all** applicants other than bursars is £770 (bank transfer or cheque). Those students who have been awarded a bursary by the Faculty should contact the Examinations Office for the relevant fee (asstreg@apothecaries.org).
- The examination re-entry fee is £265 for the dissertation/essay and £265 for the test lecture.

WITHDRAWING FROM THE EXAMINATION

- Candidates who wish to withdraw from the examination must notify the Society in writing. The following withdrawal penalties will be applied:

If the date of receipt of notification of withdrawal falls –	
Before the application closing date stated above	No penalty
In the two weeks after the application deadline	£110
Within 6 weeks of the start of the examination	£210
Within 2 weeks of the start of the examination	Full fee
