The Musical Museum

**An exclusive visit on Thursday, 22nd August 2019
starting at 10:30 am and including lunch**

The Musical Museum is home to one of the world's foremost collections of musical instruments that play themselves! From tiny musical boxes to self-playing pianos, orchestrions, pipe organs and violin players, we can learn about the history of music reproduction and, above all, hear from the impressive array of exhibits. We are even given a brief recital on the Mighty Wurlitzer theatre organ – see below!

This will be a truly joyous visit, which starts with coffee at 10:30 followed at 11:00 by a 90 minute conducted tour of the three Museum galleries. Our exclusive visit continues with lunch at the Museum itself, followed by post-lunch coffee in the Concert Hall, listening to a magical recital on the Mighty Wurlitzer which rises out of the floor in classic fashion!

Located near Kew Bridge, Brentford, the Musical Museum features prominently in "Things to do in Greater London" and is well served by public transport, although there is a car park, too! The cost of this really life-enhancing event will be £55 per head, including a two-course lunch, with a glass of wine, or soft drinks, and, of course, coffee or tea.
