Wexford is a charming ancient Viking seaport on the River Slaney in Ireland's sunny South East. At festival time the streets are abuzz with excitement amid the art galleries, craft shops and hostelries.

The trip will include four dinners (three pre-theatre) at premium local restaurants, each followed by one of the three festival opera productions (details below - *black tie required*).

There is also the option of attending additional performances including daily lunchtime recitals, the afternoon pocket operas and the Late Night Cabaret des Artistes. An optional sightseeing tour is also planned - more information to come.

The festival features free community events with pop-up performances featuring music, drama, singing and dance around the town.

Participants have the choice of joining the group flying from London or making their own way to Wexford. Accommodation will be at the excellent 4 star Talbot Hotel located in the town centre.
