

Bird-watching visit to and luncheon at Elmley National Nature Reserve (NNR, Isle of Sheppey, north Kent) on Monday 27 September 2021 (10:30 for 11:00am start)



Whether you are an experienced birdwatcher, someone familiar with birds in your own garden or completely new to bird-watching, you will see an amazing variety of wild birds on this visit. The reserve at Elmley, located close to the Isle of Sheppey bridge, comprises 3,300 acres of farmland and extensive reedbeds, with purpose-built hides overlooking lagoons, accessed by a track that follows the Swale seawall.

The reserve is most easily accessed by car (sat nav post code: ME12 3RW) though may also be reached by rail and taxi (rail to Sittingbourne station, A2 taxis (outside station) to the reserve buildings, £15-20 each way). Visitors are encouraged to bring their own binoculars; if you don't have a pair, they may be hired on the day (£5 each).

The visit will last a minimum of four hours and include a light luncheon following our bird-watching tour (details below). Visitors will be transported from the reserve buildings in a Saviem 4x4 transporter (or a tractor-drawn trailer, depending on visitor numbers) to each of three birdwatching hides; there will therefore be a limited amount of flat to slightly uneven walking involved. Please bring clothing suitable for all weather conditions and walking shoes – at this time of year, Elmley may be anything from wet and windy to warm and sunny!

The cost will be £60 per person. Early booking is encouraged as the reserve can only host a maximum of 20 visitors on the visit; places will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Further details will be sent nearer the time for all Apothecaries and their guests booked on the visit.

- 10:30 Arrival with tea or coffee and pastries
- 11:00 Introductory talk (outline of the day, the reserve and its history, birds and other wildlife, what visitors are likely to see)
- 11:30 Start of our tour
- 13:30 Lunch (served in the Linhay, a covered area)
- 15:00 End of lunch (visitors are welcome to leave after lunch or enjoy free-time on the reserve until 17:00)
- 17:00 End of our visit
