## The Worshipful Society of Apothecaries Livery Committee visit to Margate, at the Turner Contemporary Gallery and the Walpole Bay Hotel 27th July 2022

Margate has always been a popular venue for holidaymakers, including Royalty, to this seaside resort from London. Not only for entertainment but for its genteel Victorian glamour, to attract the likes of TS Elliott and JMW Turner to name a few. Recently, it has seen a resurgence over the past decade for its sandy beaches, entertainment, restaurants, art at the Turner Contemporary Gallery and cultural events besides the Shell Grotto or the Margate Caves and the Hornby Museum.

Today, Margate is easily accessible by the high-speed train from St Pancras (HS1) but also more frequent but slower South Eastern services from Victoria or Cannon Street. By car the M20 and M2 motorways are close by.

The attendees on this trip are scheduled to meet from 10.30am over refreshments at the Turner Contemporary Gallery (post code CT9 1HG) followed by a talk at 11.00am by the Curator, Sarah Martin, to include a history of the Gallery and its association with artists such as Turner, Gormley, Emin etc and its past exhibition highlights. Followed by a guided tour of the Gallery with guide(s), depending on our group size.

At approximately, 1.00pm some of the attendees may wish to walk (20 minutes), weather permitting, to the Walpole Bay Hotel (post code CT9 2JJ) along the seashore or a few minutes' drive by car. A map and details showing some of the other venues will be provided to interested members and will be circulated. At the Hotel 2.00pm, we will be greeted with a

glass of Prosecco and the Walpole Cream Tea, Cakes & Sandwiches. A guided tour of this wonderful Victorian Hotel, Museum and Gallery has also been organised.

As there are many other venues of interest locally, as indicated above, some members may wish to stay overnight but they must contact the Hotel independently.
