Visit to Freemasons' Hall, Great Queen Street, and lunch

Saturday 19 November 2022 starting at 11o'clock

Freemasons' Hall in Great Queen Street was built on the site of previous Halls dating back to 1775. Completed in 1933 as a memorial to the thousands of Freemasons who died in the First World War, Freemasons' Hall is recognised as one of the finest Art Deco buildings in England.

The visit will start at 11 o'clock with a guided tour of Freemasons' Hall taking in the museum and library, the Grand Temple and the Vestibules. Together, the collections at the museum, library and archives have been awarded 'Designated Outstanding' status by the Arts Council. The tour will conclude with pre-lunch drinks in one of the Vestibules followed by lunch, 3 courses with wine, in the Grand Officers' Robing Room. We expect to finish about 3.00pm.

Accessibility – there are lifts to all floors.
