ABOUT THE SPEAKER:

CAROLYN WAS CHIEF EXECUTIVE OF MERLIN FROM 2005 TO 2013. SHE WAS PREVIOUSLY DIRECTOR FOR EUROPE, MIDDLE EAST AND AMERICAS AT THE UK DEPARTMENT FOR INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT AND DIRECTOR OF PROGRAMMES AT SAVE THE CHILDREN. SHE HAS LIVED AND WORKED IN MOZAMBIQUE / SOUTHERN AFRICA AND NICARAGUA.

CAROLYN HAS MORE RECENTLY UNDERTAKEN A RANGE OF INTERIM MANAGEMENT, CONSULTANCY AND GOVERNANCE ASSIGNMENTS. THIS HAS INCLUDED WORKING WITH PUBLIC HEALTH ENGLAND ON THEIR GLOBAL PROGRAMMES AND AN EVALUATION OF OXFAM'S EBOLA RESPONSE. AS CHAIR OF INTRAC FROM 2015-2021 SHE HAS BEEN INVOLVED IN THE PRACTICAL WAYS TO SHIFT TO LOCAL LEADERSHIP.
