APPLICATIONS

- To avoid disappointment, candidates are advised to apply for the examination well in advance of the closing date for entries, and to ensure that their application arrives in the Examinations Office by the deadline date and time. The deadline is the **final** date / time that a completed application can be considered for entry to the examination **but there is no guarantee that places will still be available at this date**. Please note that an application is only deemed complete when it includes all relevant paperwork and the full fee.
- Although 2 OSCE dates are shown, the examination may be held on only one of the days stated.

WAITING LIST

- The Society operates a waiting list system once all places for the examination have been filled. Candidates will be notified in writing as soon as a place becomes available, and given a short period in which to respond. Please note that should candidates not respond within this time, the place will be offered to the next person on the waiting list.

EXAMINATION FEE

- First time entry fee **£1,030 NET** Re-entry Best of Five exam fee **£412 NET** Re-entry OSCE exam fee **£618 NET**

*To re-enter for the WHOLE exam, you should make a full £1,030 payment by direct transfer (see banking details below), or select both the Bo5 AND OSCE re-entry options from our online Web shop, and complete Form R.

N.B. This is the amount payable to the Society; any transaction charges must borne by the candidate. Candidates who withdraw from the examination after the closing date will trigger a forfeit fee as detailed below.

OSCE PREFERENCES

- Candidates may express their preference for an OSCE session on the application form. Whilst we will endeavour to allocate you to one of your preferred sessions, indication of a preference does not guarantee a place for that session. The session allocated will be confirmed on the admission document, issued in hard copy after the application deadline.

THE EXAMINATION

- The examination is mapped to the **Specialty Training Curriculum for Genitourinary Medicine 2016** issued by the Joint Royal College of Physicians Training Board.

WITHDRAWING FROM THE EXAMINATION

8. Candidates who wish to withdraw from the examination must notify the Society in writing. The following withdrawal penalties will be applied:
