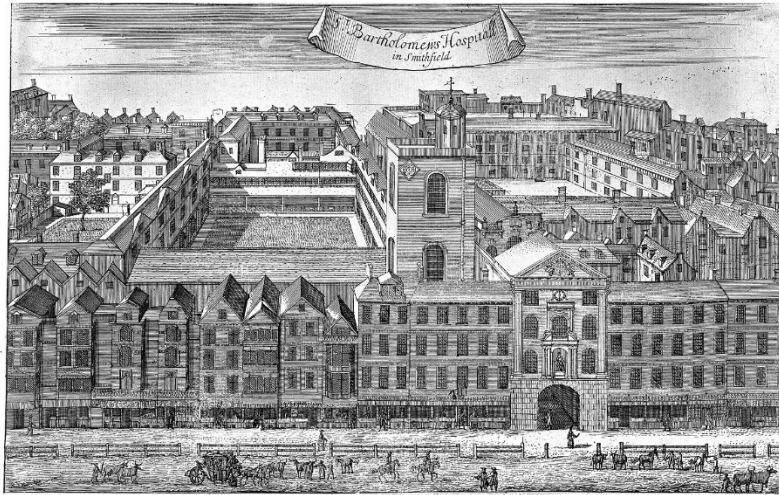


# Rough Justice, Harsh Medicine

## Healthcare, Law and the Legal System

9<sup>th</sup> August 2023 10.30am

A Walking Tour arranged by The Livery Committee



We will be meeting in Lincoln's Inn Fields and then follow a route through the heart of London's academic and medical quarter, through the historic legal district concluding at St Bartholomew's Hospital.

Along the way we will stop at an array of fascinating and diverse locations to unpick the intersections between healthcare and justice. Locations include the Royal College of Surgeons to look at the illegal methods used to obtain anatomical specimens, the Strand Union Workhouse for an appraisal of the effective criminalisation of poverty by Poor Law Reform and the Bridewell to discover the history of the joint management of the penal and mental health systems in the early modern period. At the Royal Courts of Justice, we review landmark cases on health and human rights. At Apothecaries Hall the control of medicines and poisons through legislation falls under the spotlight.

The walk will last approximately 2 ½ hours and is not suitable for those who cannot stand for this length of time. It will be followed by a hearty lunch at The Butcher's Hook and Cleaver. A menu will be circulated for your menu choices.
