Collecting and Reflecting Pharmacy History Programme

Wednesday 27 September 2023

**Morning – Science Museum –
9.50 – Muster at 165 Queens Gate
10am-Talk & Tour**

Hear from the team behind the Injecting Hope exhibition on the challenges of collecting to reflect the Covid pandemic, and enjoy a curator's tour of the display. There will also be free time to visit the Medicine Galleries, with their 3000 objects spanning over 500 years of history.

Afternoon – Economic Botany Collection, Royal Botanic Gardens Kew – Arrival 2pm

Explore the pharmacy collections that form part of the Economic Botany Collection, with a behind-the-scenes curator's tour of the store, and hear about the challenges of curating a historical pharmacy collection within colonial contexts. There will be free time to spend in the gardens during the afternoon.

Experience a guided tour of the atmospheric 17th century livery hall and its collections, and see objects and archives usually stored behind-the-scenes. We will finish the afternoon with a drinks reception and a chance to network with your fellow delegates.
